The study determined home care practices of caregivers for children with cerebral palsy in the City of San Fernando, La Union for the calendar year 2012. The result also showed that there are some strengths noted in specific activities nutrition, toileting, dressing, and rest and sleep but in general are considered as weaknesses in providing home care on the activities of daily living for children with cerebral palsy; whereas, bathing and exercise activities of daily. living for children with cerebral palsy are all found to be weaknesses of the respondents in providing home care.
