

The Factors that Influence the Productivity of Students in the Context of Online Learning

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OBJECTIVE



- * To identify the factors that influence the students' productivity in the context of online learning.
- * To determine how students can overcome the challenges brought upon by online learning, with regards to productivity.

METHODS



- * The study used the qualitative descriptive design.
- * With the purposive sampling method, we interviewed 15 Grade 11 and 12 students using an online survey.
- * And we utilized thematization to analyze our data.

BACKGROUND



The sudden shift in the students' learning atmosphere introduced various factors that can impact the students' level of productivity. Previous studies suggest that these factors include the length of deadlines, amount of internet exposure, level of self-discipline, and classroom engagement.

FINDINGS



- * A peaceful and engaging learning environment can increase the students' level of productivity.
- * Incentives and moral support motivate students to be more productive and efficient in accomplishing school activities.
- * Procrastination due to task aversiveness, distractions and lack of motivation hinders students to be efficient.
- * Strategies that can help boost their productivity include proper task and time management, discarding distractions, and focusing on goals.

RECOMMENDATIONS



The educators should increase virtual classroom interaction.

Students need to learn how to discipline themselves and possibly apply some of the mentioned strategies.

Parents should still monitor their child/children properly.
